

STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in Town of Yates effective at 1500 on April 20, 2017.


This State of Emergency has been declared due to preparedness measures being taken in anticipation of the Lake Ontario water level continually rising into late spring and becoming a long term hazard. Presently the water level continues to rise and there has been minimal flooding impacting low lying areas based on wind direction and water levels. There is presently no immediate public safety threat, the situation will continually be monitored and orders will be executed based on the circumstances at the time of concern.

This situation could potentially threatens the public safety.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order.

As the Chief Executive of the Town of Yates, I, James J. Simon, exercise the authority given me under Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of this Municipality. I hereby direct all departments and agencies of Town of Yates to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.

EMERGENCY ORDER

Local Emergency Order for: Town of Yates _____:

I, James J. Simon _____, the Chief Executive

of Town of Yates _____, in accordance with a declaration of a State of

New York State Executive Law, do hereby order that all boat traffic along the lake shores of Lake Ontario in the Town of Yates must operate at idle speed only causing no wake. This idle speed order extends out to a distance of 500 feet. This order is for the safety of boaters and residents and residences along the shoreline.


