PUBLIC HEARING

Notice of said Public Hearing was duly published in the Batavia Daily News on August 16, 2017.

The purpose of such Public Hearing is to discuss the adoption of a Local Law known as “The Lake Ontario and Connected Waterways Assessment Relief Act of 2017 (hereinafter “The Act”) to provide for assessment relief for real property improvements impacted by flooding located within the Town of Yates.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Trisha Laszewski, Town Assessor, explained how the exemption worked, provided pros and cons, and explained how the exemption would work with regard to property improvements.

Supervisor Simon asked for clarification on the term “improvements”.

She stressed that the exemption would not apply to land, break walls, decks or docks.
