

STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Town of Yates effective at 1130 hours hours on MAY 20, 2019

This State of Emergency has been declared due to preparedness measures continuing to be taken in anticipation of the Lake Ontario water level continuing to rise into late spring and becoming a long term hazard. Presently the water level continues to rise and there has been increased flooding impacting low lying areas based on wind direction and water levels. There is presently no immediate public safety threat. The situation will continually be monitored and orders will be executed based on the circumstances at the time of concern.

This situation could potentially threaten the public safety.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order.

As the Chief Executive of the Town of Yates, I, James J. Simon, exercise the authority given me under Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of this Municipality. I hereby direct all departments and agencies of Town of Yates to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.
