

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that a Public Hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Yates, at 8 South Main Street, Lyndonville, NY 14098, on Monday, April 10, 2023 at 5:30 P.M., on the adoption of a Local Law known as “A Local Law to Modify the Rules and Regulations for the Yates Town Park”, an abstract of which Local Law is set forth as follows:

SECTION I.

Section 20 of the Rules and Regulations for the Yates Town Park, adopted by Local Law 1 of 2022, is hereby deleted and replaced by the following in its entirety:

SECTION 20. USE OF PAVILION

The pavilion is authorized for any person to use unless it is reserved.

The restrooms at the pavilion are authorized for any person to use even if the pavilion is reserved.

The pavilion may be reserved by contacting the Yates Town Clerk, filling out a reservation form, and making a deposit for the amount determined by Town Board resolution. The pavilion and surrounding area must be left clean and undamaged, otherwise the deposit is forfeited.

For Town residents, half of the deposit will be returned after the Town inspects the pavilion, and for non-Town residents, the deposit amount will equal the reservation fee and will be kept by the Town.

The deposit for the pavilion is refundable up to 48 hours before the reserved date, but is nonrefundable if cancellation occurs within 48 hours of the reserved date.

Nails, thumbtacks, staples, etc. may not be used. Masking and transparent tape are allowed. All decorations must be removed at the end of the event.

When the pavilion is reserved, a RESERVED sign will be prominently posted on the pavilion and only the person or group reserving the pavilion will be authorized to use the pavilion. If there is no RESERVED sign on the pavilion, it is open for public use on a first-come, first-serve, space available basis.

The cost to reserve and use the pavilion is for the amount determined by Town Board resolution. Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis.

SECTION II.

Unless otherwise provided herein, the remaining provisions of the Rules and Regulations for the Yates Town Park as adopted by Local Law 1 of 2022 shall remain in force and effect.

SECTION IV.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

SECTION VI.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
